## Overview

Aimed at adults with commitments outside of study, this course will help you gain the skills needed for success at university!

This is a one year intensive course for adult students age 19+ who are intending to study for a degree at university but who do not have the required qualifications for entry, for example BTECs or A-Levels at Level 3.



## What you'll learn

You will study specialist Law units including:

- English Legal System
- Criminal Law: Theft, Murder, Manslaughter
- Arrest, Remand and Bail Procedure
- Tort of Negligence
- Contract Law
- Youth Justice
- Marriage
- Political Institution in Britain

## Assessments / Exams

There are written assignments on this course but no exams.

## Entry requirements

It's expected that you'll have substantial work experience before joining the course. You'll also need GCSE or Functional Skills at level 2.

The Access programme requires the study of 19 units, over 9 month period and therefore to successfully complete this programme you'll require a lot of self-discipline and resilience. It's designed for mature learners who have substantial work, personal or academic experience and can demonstrate that they have successfully overcome challenges before.

Applicants who are not 19 at the start of the academic year (the 31st August) are expected to have maths and English at level 2 and if successful in getting a place on an Access to Higher Education Diploma Programme it is compulsory that you participate in the national study programmes for the under 19s as well.

## Links with employers

We'll support you if you wish to find further work experience via placements during the programme.
