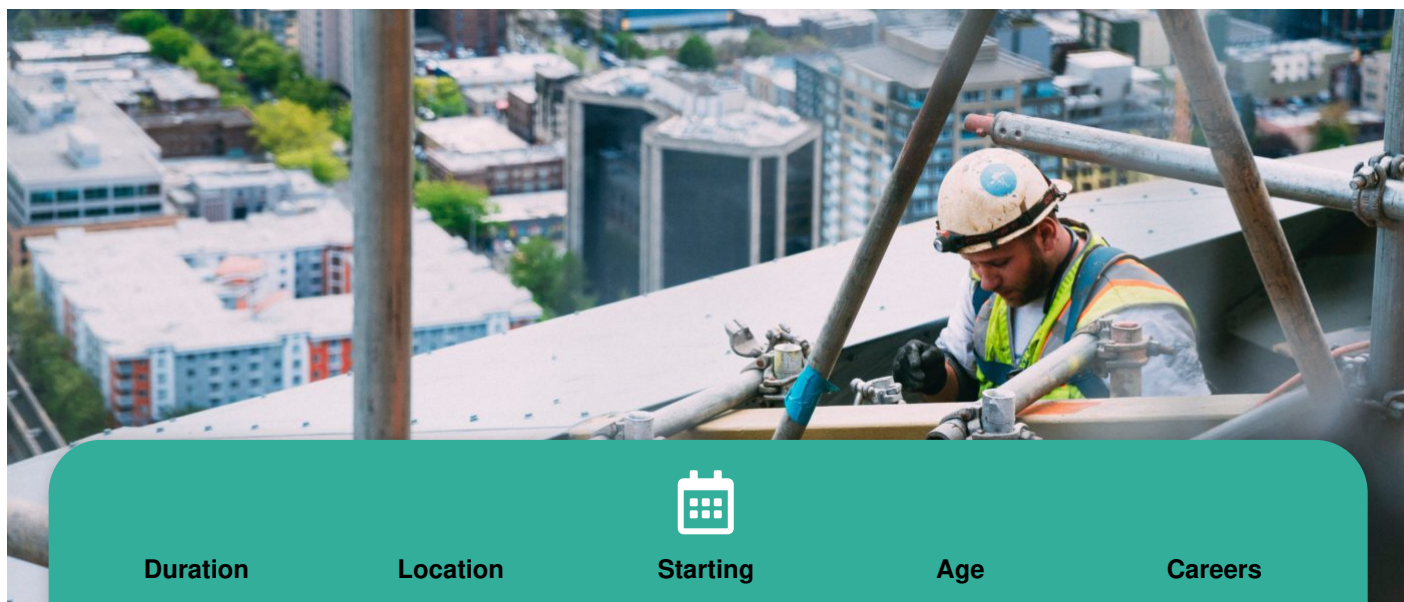

You'll need GCSEs at level 4 (C) or above to study on this course.

What this course leads to

The subsidiary year leads on to the BTEC Level 3 (Extended) Diploma in Construction and the Built Environment, which can also be studied full-time or part-time.

After successfully completing the extended year you could enter employment or choose to study at HNC or degree level.
