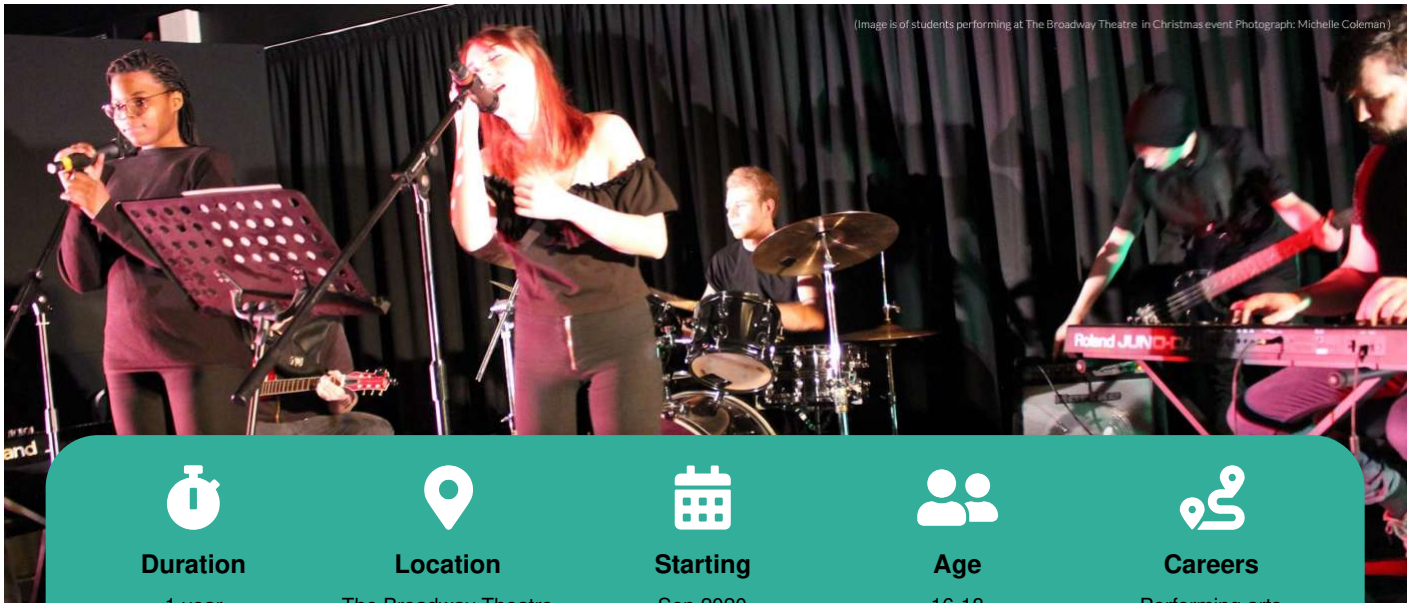

Overview

This course incorporates sequencing, Performing & Creative composition processes and aims to develop a broad skills to create an all-round 21st-century musician.

What you'll learn

The course focuses on developing a wide range of knowledge and skills and includes exploring different ways of working in various musical Styles, Creating material and sequencing techniques as well as planning a creative career. Much of the course involves practical explorations and public performances alongside project-based work as well as building a personal Portfolio.

Planning a Career in the Industry

You will study in a creatively rich environment, the Broadway Theatre in Barking. A working theatre, which is managed by Barking & Dagenham College, as well as being home to our School for the Performing Arts, Music & Technical Theatre. You will also have access to the theatre stage for both rehearsal and performances.

You will work collaboratively with other students on productions both at the Theatre and at other venues, and you will have the opportunity to create your own vibrant and innovative pieces.

Assessments / Exams

Assessments are done in a variety of ways which include: Practical rehearsals and Performances, written documents and presentations.

Entry requirements

You should have at least 4 GCSEs at level 4 or above, or grade A* - C, including Maths and English, and preferably Music or Music grades.

Admission to the course is by interview.
