## Overview

The Access to Higher Education Diploma (Social Science) is a Level 3 qualification which prepares those without traditional qualifications for study at university.



## What you'll learn

On this course you will study units on social policy, sociology, psychology and Law.

## Assessments / Exams

Assessment is by portfolio submission. You'll be assessed via a combination of written reports and practical tasks.

## Entry requirements

You will need a Level 2 Functional Skills in English or a GCSE in English grade 4+ (C or above).

The Access programme requires the study of 19 units, over 9 month period and therefore to successfully complete this programme you'll require a lot of self-discipline and resilience. It's designed for mature learners who have substantial work, personal or academic experience and can demonstrate that they have successfully overcome challenges before.

Applicants who are not 19 at the start of the academic year (the 31st August) are expected to have maths and English at level 2 and if successful in getting a place on an Access to Higher Education Diploma Programme it is compulsory that you participate in the national study programmes for the under 19s as well.
