## Overview

The Access to Higher Education (HE) Diploma is a Level 3 qualification which prepares adults without traditional qualifications for study at university.

You will have a coherent, integrated and supported year of study where you will gain the knowledge, skills and confidence necessary for successful undergraduate study.

The course aims to provide a balance of essential study skills with specialist subject knowledge in Education.

## What you'll learn

You will get an overview of Teaching and Education that will prepare you for university and a career in primary, secondary or post-compulsory sector teaching. You will learn how to study in preparation for Higher Education.

## Assessments / Exams

Skills, knowledge and understanding are assessed through:

- assignments, reports and worksheets
- presentations
- case study analysis
- artefacts such as models, leaflets and posters

There are no external exams. Three units are partially assessed through 1 hour internal exams, some of which you are allowed to take notes into.

## Entry requirements

You will need to have a Level 2 qualification in English and in maths *or* have L1 English and maths *and* be enrolled on Level 2 courses in English and maths. This is a requirement as you will need these to get into university and to cope with the demands of the Access Diploma course.

## What this course leads to

On successful completion of the course you can progress to Higher Education. Many go on to study a teaching qualification at Barking & Dagenham College ([Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training](https://www.barkingdagenhamcollege.ac.uk/level-5-diploma-in-education-and-training)), or to a degree in one of the following subjects at university:
