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NCFE Diploma in Uniform Services Level 2

Our public services qualification will prepare and train you for a role within the police force, fire service, ambulance service or armed forces.

What will I learn?

Do you want to know what it is like to work in the uniform services?

We have members of staff who have significant experience as they were in those services so they are ideally placed to help you achieve. They will teach you how to look for work in a service of your choice, teach you about becoming a good citizen in your community, the value of teamwork and take you for regular fitness tests - they will even join in! As part of this course you will also continue to develop your English and Maths skills, which need to be at a high standard for this type of career.

This is an experience in learning that you will not forget from the beginning of the course in induction week to the very end in June. You will have the opportunity to go on hikes and an outward bound course where you also take part in climbing, caving and camping overnight. You will find out about your strengths and where you need to improve too and will grow and develop as a person.

As we are preparing you to work in the public services you will be required to wear a uniform. We do ask that you meet some of the costs of the uniform required on this course which is around 140.00, plus the costs of the programme of outdoor activities which is around 250.00.

How will I be taught?

You will be taught through a mix of classroom and practical activities, including:

- health and fitness
- citizenship
- leadership and team building
- land navigation and outdoor pursuits

How will I be assessed?

You will be continually assessed throughout the year, producing written assignments, online tests, presentations and role play. You will also be observed by your tutors and peers.

On this course you can achieve a pass, merit or distinction grade. If you wish to progress on to our Level 3 programme you must achieve at least a merit.

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

You will have 2 or more GCSE grades at D or above, including English or Maths, or have successfully completed an appropriate Level 1 qualification such as the BTEC Diploma in Public Services which is also offered at Barking & Dagenham College.

If you are a mature student, previous work experience, enthusiasm and motivation to succeed and to progress will be taken into account.

What can I do after this course?

As long as you have passed this course, you can progress onto our BTEC Subsidiary Diploma in Public Services Level 3. If you achieve a distinction grade, it is equivalent to 1 A Level.

From this you can move on to the BTEC Extended Diploma in Public Services at Level 3, which is equivalent to a further 2 A Levels.
