BTEC National Diploma in Business Level 3

Our business course will train you to become a specialist business professional. Apply now to join our schools of business.



What will I learn?

As the course progresses, you will develop your skills, knowledge and understanding of what is required in the business world through taking part in a work placement in a chosen area of business.

This course provides both a broad foundation of business education and a firm basis for specialisation in your selected avenue of business activity.

The programme comprises these Mandatory Units:

- The Business Environment
- Business Resources
- Introduction to Marketing
- Business Communication

And Optional Units including:

- Creative product promotion
- Market research

How will I be taught?

This is a practical work-related course. You will learn by completing projects and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands.

You will also need to complete 2 weeks' work experience as part of your course. You do not need to have this set up at the application stage and the College will support you in securing a work experience placement if you are struggling to find one yourself.

How will I be assessed?

This is a mix of internal assessment and external exam-based assessments.

An overall grade is awarded to those who successfully complete all units. Grades awarded are Pass, Merit or Distinction.

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

You will need a minimum of 5 GCSEs at A* - C (or 4 and above), including English and Maths, or a BTEC First Diploma at a Merit level.

If you do not have GCSE English A* - C you will be asked to complete a written assessment at the interview stage.

You will also need to provide a reference from your school or college covering your attendance, punctuality, work ethic and general performance.

Applicants with alternative qualifications may be considered.

What can I do after this course?

This BTEC Subsidiary Diploma is a one year course. By April (the Spring Term), if you have successfully passed all 6 units you will be able to undertake 3 additional units which will give you a 90 credit BTEC Diploma in Business.

In year 2 you can move on to the BTEC Extended Diploma in Business at Level 3, where you will complete a further 9 units.

This will give you 18 units in total which is equivalent to 3 A Levels, which means you are ready to move on to university.

If you complete 6 units on the BTEC Subsidiary Diploma in Business, you will move on to the BTEC Diploma in Business at Level 3. Over the 2 years this 12 unit option is equivalent to 2 A Levels, from which you can also apply to university.

Will I need any special equipment?

You will be given a reading list at the start of your course and you will be expected to purchase course text books which would cost around 25.
