BTEC Extended Diploma in Construction and The Built Environment Level 3

Our construction course will help you get a job within building and construction. Classes cover construction and building technology, construction science, construction planning and building surveying.



What will I learn?

If you are thinking about joining one of the built environment professions, this is the first step on the ladder. The jobs you could be aiming for include:

Architect
Quantity Surveyor
Structural Engineer
Project Manager

This course will give you a solid foundation, as well as some practical skills in carpentry and brickwork, to give you a flavour of what its like to work in this field.

You will learn basic trade skills, such as how to build a wall and produce timber joints, in addition to theoretical knowledge about how buildings are constructed (and stay up!), sustainability and materials.

How will I be taught?

You will learn in a mixture of classroom and workshop environment. We have one of the largest Construction & the Built Environment departments in the South East, and our facilities are industry-standard and second to none.

How will I be assessed?

You will produce assignments during your course and these will be marked as you go. There is no exam to be taken.

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

Perhaps you are already working in this industry, in an office based role or as a labourer, and you are looking for your first chance at promotion. Alternatively you may be working part-time in an other industry and looking to break into this industry.

Ideally you will have 4 GCSEs at Grade D or above (including Maths and English), however, we welcome your application if you have equivalent qualifications or relevant work experience

What can I do after this course?

You could move on to the BTEC Subsidiary Diploma in Construction & the Built Environment at Level 3, which we also offer part-time.
