# CACHE Level 3 Award & Certificate in Health and Social Care

This programme aims to provide learners with an in-depth knowledge of core subject areas in health and social care to support progression into Higher Education, the workplace or further learning in related subject areas.

## What will I learn?

If you are interested in a career in nursing or social work and want to move on to university for further study you will need to complete this course before moving on to the CACHE Extended Diploma in Health and Social Care at Level 3.

You will study the CACHE Certificate for one year, and the Extended Diploma for the second year. To progress to university you will need to achieve a Grade C overall.

You will study a range of important units which build your knowledge, confidence and opportunities for that future valuable career. This programme also aims to improve your research and study skills in preparation for university, including:

- Communication;
- Equality, Diversity and Rights;
- Vocational Experience;
- Psychology;
- Sociology;
- Reflective Practice

To qualify at Level 3 you have to successfully achieve 100 hours mandatory placement for the year which is formed of at least one day a week.

## How will I be taught?

You will take part in classroom sessions, project work, discussion groups, practical work experience placements and visits.

You must also complete a work placement for 1 day a week for the whole year. You must complete the Disclosure Barring System process (which used to be known as a CRB check) which we will organise for you, to enable you to work in the sector.

## How will I be assessed?

You will produce a portfolio of work that is assessed by a range of methods, which may include projects, assignments, case studies and coursework.

Students are allocated a personal tutor who will provide support and guidance at regular intervals during the course.

## What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

You will need 5 GCSEs at Grade A\* to C, including English, Maths and a Science subject.

## What can I do after this course?

Award: Upon achievement of this qualification learners will be able to progress to the Level 3 Certificate in Health and Social Care.

Certificate: Upon achievement of this qualification learners will be able to progress to the Level 3 Extended Diploma in Health and Social Care.
