## **Up to £10,000 loan towards your fees for a Masters**

A Master's loan is available to help students meet the cost of the fees. Ask our Student Financial Support team for more information and find out if you're eligible: 020 3667 0050

- Students must be under the age of 60
- You can borrow up to a maximum of £10,000 for the purpose of completing a postgraduate Master's qualification
- The loan will be administered by [Student Finance England](#)
- You can use the loan to undertake study at a [Higher Education Funding Council for England \(HEFCE\)](#) fundable institution - this includes Barking & Dagenham College
- The course must be either 1 - 2 years full-time or 2- 4 years part-time
- The loan is not paid out in one go and payments will be dependent on your attendance on the course
- You only start repaying the loan when you earn over £21,000 a year, with repayments at 9% of salary above this income threshold

## What will I learn?

This MBA programme, validated by Glyndwr University, will provide you with further insight and knowledge into Marketing, Leadership, Managing Change and Innovation, Finance and Strategic Thinking.

This will be delivered at strategic level and equip you with the needed knowledge to make strategic decisions in a more complex business environment either at local or in a global business context.

The course covers these key management concepts including:

- Implementing Strategies
- Integrated Communications
- Financial Insights and Business Intelligence
- Contemporary Leadership Themes
- Emphasising the Environment
- Creative Change and Innovation
- Research Methods and Dissertation

The MBA programme has been developed in accordance with the QAA Benchmark standard and the programme team has planned the curriculum to align with the Benchmarks for knowledge and understanding within the framework.

## How will I be taught?

You will be taught using variety of methods and experience. These will include:

- Lectures and seminars
- Practical workshops and demonstrations
- Group debates and tutorial sessions
- Organised visits to businesses
- Guest lecturers and professional engagement from businesses, conferences etc.

## How will I be assessed?

This programme uses a wide range of assessment methods including Course work and examinations. These are set by the university, first and second at the college and moderated by the university. We operate strictly in line with the university assessment policy and procedures.

Successful student will be invited to a graduation ceremony at Glyndwr University.

## What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

Entry requirements for each programme with regards to academic qualifications and English levels will be adhered to as set by Glyndwr University and will include the process to be used for advanced standing and the use of credit for exemption.

- A full level 6, BA (Hons) Business Management or BA (Hons) Business Accounting will allow full entry to the full time and part time MBA.
- The Chartered Management Institute (CMI) Level 7, Strategic Management and Leadership Diploma, will allow full entry with advanced standing to the full time and part time MBA, subject to approval by the University.
- An initial Honours degree of Glyndwr University or another approved degree awarding body.
- Equivalent overseas qualifications deemed satisfactory by the programme team.
- A non-graduate qualification which the University deems to be of satisfactory standard for the purpose of post-graduate admission.
- Have relevant work experience that is deemed to compensate the lack of formal qualifications and have held a position of management responsibility for a minimum of three years within the previous five years.

## What can I do after this course?

Many people equate success and even happiness to their pay packet. Well it is good news for those with an MBA. According to the Association of MBAs (AMBA), those returning to work following their MBA do see an increase in salary.

In fact the average salary of an MBA graduate is over 80,000 British pounds. So if it is money you are after, an MBA may well be an opportunity you should explore. You may like to take a step toward the academic route through a Ph.D. programme.
