

What will I learn?

Delivered by Barking & Dagenham College in partnership with The Prince's Trust, the Team programme is designed especially for young people like you uncover your hidden talents, improve your confidence and help you make the right choices about your future.

The Team programme is a free 12-week course designed for young adults age 16 to 24 to help uncover hidden talents and improve confidence through:

- Personal development
- Team building activities
- Work experience
- Practical skills
- Community projects (A great chance to make a difference in your community)
- An action packed residential week
- A nationally recognised qualification
- Developing English and maths skills

How will I be taught?

You will study in a group of no more than 15 young people, supported by a specifically trained Team Leader and Assistant Team Leader.

You will work on a range of community projects and undertake work experience whilst completing your accredited employability and skills qualification.

The 12-week programme includes a week long activity residential, which you will play a key role in planning yourself. This gives you a chance to bond with your fellow students and work as a team.

You will have the opportunity to develop your CV, receive help with job hunting, hone your interview skills and work with an employer of your choice to gain valuable experience.

You will improve your English and Maths skills through participating in this course. Extra help will be arranged if needed.

How will I be assessed?

You will complete a portfolio of work for The Prince's Trust accredited Employment, Teamwork and Community Skills qualification which is offered at Entry 3, Level 1 and Level 2, to evidence your knowledge and understanding and reflect on their own learning and contribution

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

There are no formal entry requirements but you will be required to take the initial College assessment to ensure we place you in the right level for the course.

What can I do after this course?

If you successfully complete The Team programme you are well-placed to progress onto a variety of different programmes within the College, external training courses, a Traineeship or an Apprenticeship.

Alternatively, you may wish to move on to employment.

Will I need any special equipment?

You do not need any special equipment, just lots of enthusiasm!
