What will I learn?

This business qualification can give you the skills you need to achieve your ambitions.

During your studies, you will cover:

How will I be taught?

You will be taught using a variety of methods and experiences. These include:

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by coursework, individual presentations, and group presentations. There are no formal exams on this programme.

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

You need to be at least 18 years old, hold five GCSEs at grades A to C (including English and maths), and have one of the following qualifications:

- BTEC National Diploma or Certificate in Business
- Advanced GNVQ in Business
- One A-level

Mature candidates with considerable work experience are also considered.

You will need to attend an interview and bring evidence of your qualifications. You might also need to sit a written test.

What can I do after this course?

On successfully completing your course, you will be awarded a Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Business. This could enable you to:

- Develop your own business ambitions
- Progress to the Higher National Diploma in Business
- Seek employment or advance your current career
