What will I learn?

This programme is designed to meet the needs of middle managers wishing to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to develop their career in management. The programme concentrates on the practical application of management theory and principles in the context of the developing middle manager, thus providing a foundation for continuing professional and personal development in management.

The following modules will be undertaken:

- Personal development as a manager and leader
- Information based decision making
- Performance management
- Human Resource development
- Resource management
- Meeting stakeholder and quality needs
- Conducting a management project
- Marketing planning
- Managing recruitment and selection

What qualifications do I need to qualify for this course?

Applicants may already possess the Diploma in First Line Management, or equivalent qualification. Management experience at and around this level is also important. A good level of English written skills and ability to use a computer for research and assignment writing is essential. Applicants will be interviewed and may be given a written test.

What can I do after this course?

With the right management experience and a good level of attainment you may proceed to CMI Extended Diploma in Strategic Management and Leadership Level 7. You could also use the Level 5 qualification to embark upon a BA in Business Management and, depending on the university, you may get remission. The Level 5 qualification will also enable you to progress in your career as a manager and membership of the Chartered Management Institute will be offered to you upon completion of your studies.
