Overview

Are you thinking about a career in the emergency services, army or civil service?

This qualification has been designed to ensure learners develop the skills and behaviours that will give them the best opportunity to be successful when applying for work in public services.

To gain the full qualification within its time, it is recognised that this achievement requires hard work, motivation, good attendance and punctuality.

This course includes a number of talks with current Protective Services workers, as well as outward bounds trips and a week-long residential stay in Wales! The course physical elements include; fitness sessions, hiking and one weeks residential.

What you'll learn

The qualification contains both mandatory and optional units which relate directly to the skills, knowledge and behaviours expected by employers in the public services sector. The areas covered include:
